Conewago Township cordially invites you to attend a **Community Public Meeting** for township residents at **Conewago Elementary School on Tuesday, June 12, 2007, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.** Conewago Township is in the process of reviewing and updating the existing comprehensive plan to guide local decision making in the township over the next ten to fifteen years and would like your input as a valued member of the community. In general, the plan will focus on preserving and protecting the township's agrarian heritage and retaining the rural lifestyle that makes the township a quality place to live.

Comprehensive plans organize and coordinate the interrelated collection of people, ideas, facilities, services, infrastructure, land uses and environmental elements that comprise the township. Thus, the term "comprehensive" is used to express the scope of plan content. Encouraging township residents and business owners to share their creative ideas and concerns will help to form a vision, goals and objectives for the plan that accurately reflect the feelings of the community. Aided by input from this meeting, the comprehensive plan committee will begin to finalize the plan components.

Planning is not a new concept to Conewago Township. This plan will serve as an update to the 1981 comprehensive plan, and the Township has also adopted a zoning ordinance, subdivision and land development ordinance, and an Act 537 sewage facilities plan. The Conewago Township Comprehensive Plan will focus on needs specific to the township, while taking into consideration the more general regional perspective.

The Community Public Meeting represents an opportunity for residents and business owners to get involved and to demonstrate their passion and care for the future of their community. The meeting will be held:
